Welcome to the New Year!

'Chaos' (it seems with recent COVID transmission on the East Coast) could become the norm for a little while longer as we try and negotiate our summer travel and recreation and anything else we had planned. I am led to believe that 'chaos' is borrowed from the Greek word that means "abyss." In ancient Greece, 'Chaos' was originally thought of as the abyss or emptiness that existed <u>before things came into being</u>.

Richard Rohr reflects that; "The word change normally refers to new beginnings. But transformation more often happens <u>not when something new begins but when something old falls apart</u>. The pain of something old falling apart—disruption and chaos—invites the soul to listen at a deeper level. It invites and sometimes forces the soul to go to a new place because the old place is not working anymore." He suggests that, "The mystics use many words to describe this chaos: fire, darkness, death, emptiness, abandonment, trial, the Evil One. Whatever it is, it does not feel good and it does not feel like God. We will do anything to keep the old thing from falling apart."

Epiphany – or 'the revealing' – therefore takes on a new meaning potentially as we face the ravaging of the COVID virus and everything associated with it. Where is God in all of this pandemic? No matter where we are, who we are – GOD IS HERE, right beside us and our struggles and anxiety and whatever else we are dealing with.

Rohr goes onto say, "Transformation usually includes a disconcerting reorientation. Change can either help people to find a new meaning, or it can cause people to close down and turn bitter. The difference is determined by the quality of our inner life, or what we call 'spirituality."

As we embrace the unknowns of a New Year - and all that will be revealed, I encourage each and every one of us to nurture our 'inner life' that can guide, equip and help us to embrace our endeavours with renewed energy and insight. How we do that is up to our individual disciplines and expressions. I also hope that as a faith community we can help show others what is possible through the 'revealing' nature and truth of a God who loves us, and calls us each by name. Rev James

TODAY'S READINGS EPIPHANY OF OUR LORD

First Reading: Isaiah 60:1-6

A reading from the book of Isaiah 'Arise, shine, for your light has come,

and the glory of the Lord rises upon you. See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the Lord rises upon you and his glory appears over you. Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn. 'Lift up your eyes and look about you: all assemble and come to you; your sons come from afar, and your daughters are carried on the hip. Then you will look and be radiant, your heart will throb and swell with joy; the wealth on the seas will be brought to you, to you nations the riches of the will come. Herds of camels will cover your land, young camels of Midian and Ephah. And all from Sheba will come, bearing gold and incense and proclaiming the praise of the Lord .

A reading from the letter of Paul to the Ephesians

For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles - Surely you have heard about the administration of God's grace that was given to me for you, that is, the mystery made known to me by revelation, as I have already written briefly. In reading this, then, you will be able to understand insight into the mystery Christ, which was not made known to people in other generations as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to God's holy apostles and prophets. This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus. I became a servant of this gospel by the gift of God's grace given me through the working of his power. Although I am less than the least of all the Lord's people, this grace was given me: to preach to the boundless Gentiles the riches Christ, and to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery, which for ages past was kept hidden in God, who created all things. His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold

wisdom of God should be made known towhere the Messiah was to be born. 'In

the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, according to his eternal purpose that he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord. In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.

Gospel:

Matthew 2:1-12

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Matthew

After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magifrom the east came to Jerusalem and asked, 'Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him.' When King Herod heard this he was disturbed, and all Jerusalem with him. When he had called together all the people's chief priests and teachers of the law, he asked them

Bethlehem in Judea,' they replied, 'for this is what the prophet has written: "But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for out of you will come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel." Then Herod called the Magi secretly and found out from the exact time the star appeared. He sent them to Bethlehem and said, 'Go and search carefully for the child. As soon as you find him, report to me, so that I too may go and worship him.' After they had heard the king, they went on their way, and the star they had seen when it rose went ahead of them until it stopped over the place where the child was. When they saw the star, they were overjoyed. On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshipped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their country by another route.
